1. Competition

Authorized by CMAS and organized by the Chinese Taipei Underwater Federation, we invite all interested Federations and Clubs to participate in the 2025 CMAS World Cup Freediving Indoor in Kaohsiung City. This World Cup is not only a sports competition but also a wonderful opportunity for the freediving community to come together. The event will take place from September 9 to September 11, 2025.

4. Registration for the Competition

To participate, you must:

- 1. Review and understand the CMAS Pool World Cup Rules and Regulations.
- 2. Register as a competitor through the **CMAS Portal**.
- 3. Pay the entry fee (details below).
- 4. Pay an additional €25 for the CMAS World Cup license (via the CMAS Portal during registration).

Entry Fee

- Paid by 18.08.2025:
 - €200 (two-day event)
- Paid after 18.08.2025:
 - €250 (two-day event)
 - €200 (one-day event)
- CMAS World Cup License Fee: €25 (paid directly to CMAS through the Portal).

Due to organizational requirements, the entry fee and registration must be completed by **25.08.2025**.

According to CMAS rules, the competition order will be based on participants' personal best results.

Admission Requirements

- Present a valid medical certificate (issued within the past year) indicating fitness for freediving.
- Be at least 18 years old.
- Present a valid ID or passport on the day of check-in.
- Sign the waiver of liability declaration.

5. Competition Regulations

The competition is scheduled over two days (September 10 and 11, 2025). Each athlete may choose one discipline per day and may also repeat the same discipline on both days if desired. Mixed-discipline starts are allowed. Only the senior category is included.

Scoring and Classification

- 1. Overall Winners Classification
- 2. Medal Classification by Discipline (DYN, DYNBF, DNF)

Overall Winners Classification

DYN: 1 point per meter
DYNBF: 1 point per meter
DNF: 1.25 points per meter

For example:

DYN: 100 m → 100 points
 DYNBF: 95 m → 95 points

• DNF: 80 m × 1.25 → 100 points

• Total: 295 points

Performances from all three disciplines (or the best result if fewer than three are attempted) will be combined for the overall classification.

Medal Classification by Discipline

Medals will be awarded for the top three men and top three women in each discipline (DYN, DYNBF, DNF). The single best performance in each discipline is taken into account.

The International Testing Agency (ITA) will determine the testing plan and provide it to the Local Organizing Committee (LOC). Additional individual tests by CMAS may occur during the competition.

All controls and procedures fall under CMAS authority for testing and result management. Benzodiazepine testing may be conducted according to CMAS procedures.



Invitation

The Chinese Taipei Underwater Federation, authorized by CMAS, invites all interested federations and clubs to participate in the 2025 CMAS World Cup Finswimming Indoor, which will be held in Kaohsiung City from September 12 to 14, 2025.

1. Registration Process

Please refer to the attached Technical Notice for details regarding the registration process through the CMAS Portal.

Registration Fees

CMAS Fees

- o Each competitor must pay CMAS fees, which are determined annually by CMAS.
- o The participation fee per round in 2025 is **€25.00**.



- Relay team members must be registered individually, even if they are competing solely in relay events. The relay composition may be adjusted on-site before the competition begins.
- Payments must be completed online via credit card at the end of the registration process.

• Organization Fees

- €25.00 per club.
- €18.00 per relay team.



- Fees are non-refundable in case of athlete non-participation.
- Late enrollments will not be accepted as registration is managed through the CMAS system within the designated timeframe.

3. Equipment Check & Regulations

Judges may inspect swimmers' equipment at any time during the competition.

Compressed-Air Breathing Apparatus Rules (CMAS 2.5.3.4)

- Only compressed air (without oxygen enrichment) is allowed.
- · Minimum cylinder volume:
 - o **0.4 liters** for pool competitions.
 - o **1.0 liters** for 200m and 400m immersion events.
- Maximum filling pressure: 200 bar (20 MPa).





- Cylinders must pass a hydrostatic test within two years before the competition.
- Cylinders must be presented empty at the equipment check meeting.

4. Classification & Scoring

Individual Rankings:

- Separate classifications for men and women, juniors and seniors.
- Includes both club and national team swimmers.

Club Rankings:

- Based on total individual points (men, women, junior, senior) registered under a club.
- Separate rankings for Senior Men, Senior Women, Junior Boys, and Junior Girls.

National Team Rankings:

- Based on total individual points (men, women, junior, senior) under a national team.
- Separate rankings for Senior Men, Senior Women, Junior Boys, and Junior Girls.

Country Rankings:

- Determined by the total individual points of national team members.
- If a National Federation does not enroll a national team, the top two club results will
 contribute to the country ranking.

5.Awards

- Individual Prizes: Medals for the top three finishers in each individual and relay event.
- Team Prizes: Cups for the top three clubs and national teams.
- Award ceremonies will be conducted during the competition. Athletes must wear official team uniforms.

6.Anti-Doping Compliance

- WADA World Anti-Doping Code
- CMAS Anti-Doping Rules
- Compliance with these regulations is mandatory for participation.

7.Liability Disclaimer

The organizing federation, organizing committee, CMAS, competition director, competition officers,





and chief judge are **not responsible** for any accidents, injuries, or personal property damage occurring before, during, or after the competition.

8.Visas

- A visa is required for entry into Republic of China (Taiwan).
- Participants needing assistance must contact the organizers and provide relevant details at least two months in advance, no later than July 1, 2025.
